

'World's best' B&B and bay hotel up for excellence awards

»AN AWARD-winning Torquay bed and breakfast hotel has been given another accolade.

The 25 B&B in Avenue Road has already been named best B&B in the world by users of the Tripadvisor website for the second year running.

Now it is one of two Torquay hotels in the finals of VisitEngland's annual national awards for excellence.

Babbacombe's Cary Arms is also among the finalists.
